



HILLTOP SPEEDWAY GETTING SPRUCED UP FOR 2012 SEASON

Rain caused almost half of the 2011 season to be cancelled, but Mother Nature has been good to the track in the off season as many improvements have been going on since the end of last race season.

Over 400 ton of clay has been distributed over the racing surface for starters which should make the track even faster. Higher guardrail and catch fencing has been installed in turns one and two plus more guardrailing and fence has gone up in turn three. All the components for more grandstand seating is on the grounds and in the process of being put up with a good chance of a couple of loges being built. The concession stand and the tower have been improved. Also a new look website will be up if not already for the fans and drivers to keep up with the activity at Hilltop Speedway.

Driver registration is now underway and until March 1st, the fee is \$100 with a free pass for the car owner that is good all year providing the car is there each night. After March 1st, the fee goes up to \$200. Season tickets for the grandstands are also now available for \$250 while season pit passes are \$500.
